Whau Scholarship

AIC is offering a scholarship of 100% of tuition fees for a Whau Local Board area student for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. The scholarship is valid for the entire duration of study at AIC (Years 11-13), and applies only to the tuition fee (please refer to the Fees Schedule for more information).

Scholarships will only be granted to and remain valid for students who:

- Study the IB Diploma Programme at AIC until completion.
- Maintain a minimum academic average score of 35 points for the entire duration of study at AIC.
- Maintain effort at A or B level for the duration of the scholarship.
- Maintain a satisfactory attitude, reflected in an ability to comply with all AIC rules, and reflected in active participation in extracurricular activities.

To be eligible for the Whau Scholarship, students need to be able to demonstrate personal qualities which indicate that they will be valuable, contributing and responsible members of the Whau community.

Applicants need to:

- Complete the Scholarship Application Form.
- Attach copies of their two most recent school reports together with evidence of success in at least one extracurricular activity.
- Provide proof of address.
- Sit an entry test at AIC.
